1. **Coming and Going** – Check in is at The Brimark Inn at 3200 W. Russell Street in Sioux Falls (332-2000) from 11:45 am to 12:30 pm on Saturday, Sept. 17. *TARs in Action* will end at the hotel at 1:15 pm on Sunday, Sept. 18.
2. **Accommodations** – We will be staying at the The Brimark Inn at 3200 W. Russell Street in Sioux Falls (332-2000). Rooms are already reserved for this event and will have two beds and will house three or four TARs. Chaperones will be present.
3. **What to bring:**
 - “Community service comfortable” clothes for Saturday and Sunday, and comfortable shoes for walking
 - A jacket, as it may be chilly on Saturday night
 - Overnight necessities – shampoo, soap, toothbrush, pajamas, etc.
 - Swim suit for possible swimming Saturday evening (optional)
 - The enclosed medical release form
 - \$45 registration fee (if you bring two non-perishable food items with you, your cost will only be \$40)

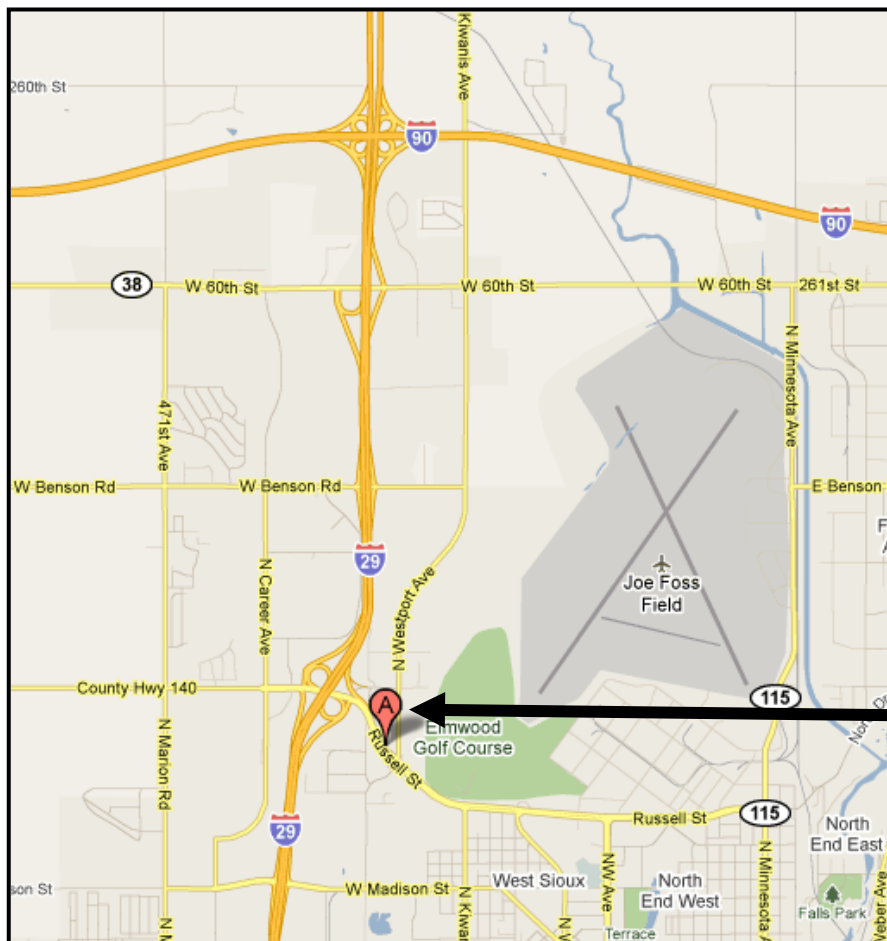
Directions to The Brimark
